And our services do not require a Medicare card.

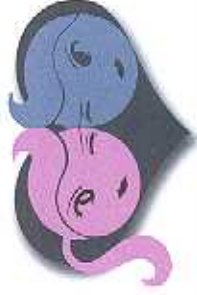
The service is provided to all areas of the

The sex Industry Project is based at a number of locations in the Sydney metropolitan area.

## **Services to the Industry**

### **Outreach**

The project operates a weekly outreach service. There are both day and night outreaches to work places. Safe sex supplies, resources, referrals, information and support are provided.

### **Resources**

The project maintains up to date educational material on issues that effect those in the sex industry such as:

- Sexual health
- Worker issues
- Legal information
- Taxation
- Workplace health & safety

### **Clinical services**

All clinics offer services that include:

- HIV & Sexually Transmitted Infection screening
- Work certificates
- Treatments of STIs
- Hepatitis testing
- Free vaccinations for Hep B
- Contraceptive advice
- Pap smears
- Sex work supplies (condoms, lube and dams)
- Information, resources and referrals
- Needle and syringe program

## **Services to the Industry**

### **Counselling and Support Services**

The counselling team is made up of experienced female and male counsellors. They provide face to face and telephone counselling.

We also act as a point of contact for sexual assault and domestic violence services.

### **Sex Industry Support**

To talk to the sex industry project officer make an appointment by contacting one of the clinics.

The sex industry project maintains a close relationship with the Sex Workers Outreach Project (SWOP) telephone 9319 4866.

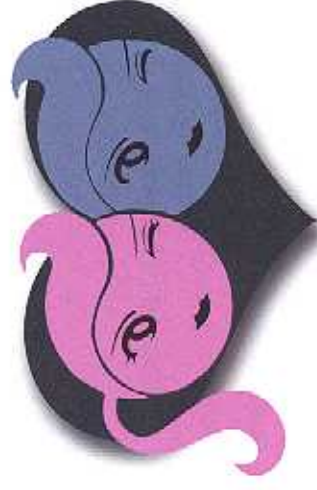
### **Other Languages**
